Essentials of Facility Management

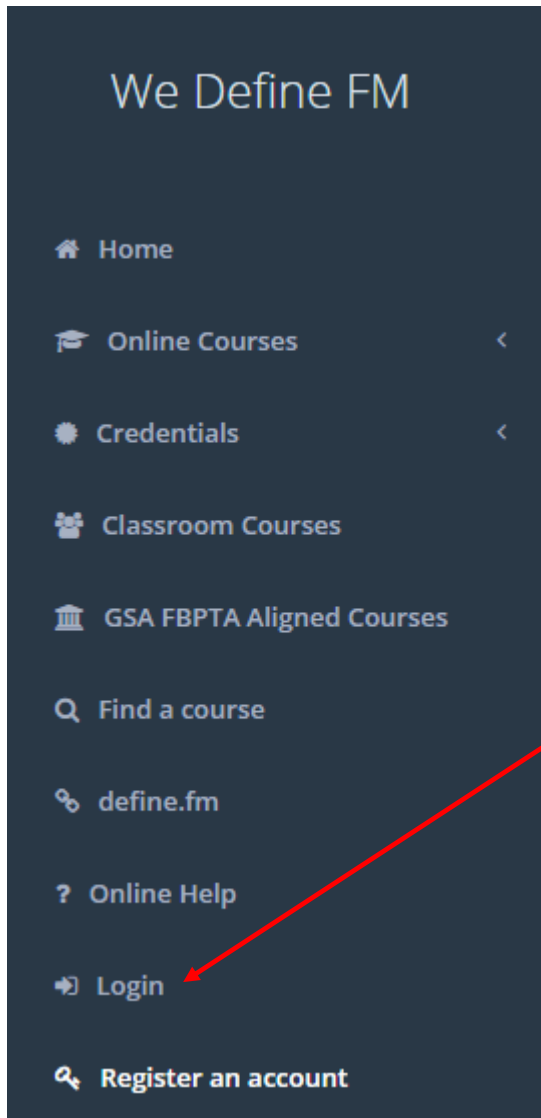




